

STANDING RULES OF THE ILLINOIS MOSQUITO AND VECTOR CONTROL ASSOCIATION

Standing Rules should contain only such rules as may be adopted without previous notice by a majority vote at any business meeting. At any meeting they may be suspended by a majority vote, or they may be amended or rescinded by a two-thirds vote. If notice of the proposed action was given at a previous meeting or in the call for this meeting, they may be amended or rescinded by a majority vote. No standing rule, or resolution, or motion is in order that conflicts with the constitution, or by-laws or standing rules (Robert's Rules of Order Revised).

Standing Rule 1. Adopted March 24, 1988 - Executive Board

The Program Chairman may be allowed expenditures of up to \$1,000.00 to use to defray travel expenses for speakers at the Annual Meeting of the IMVCA (providing there are ample funds in the Treasury).

Standing Rule 2. Adopted September 15, 1988 - Executive Board

The registration fee for the annual meeting will be waived for all speakers who are non-members of the Association.

Standing Rule 3. Adopted September 7, 1989 - Executive Board

The Association may pay for one night's lodging (night prior to Annual Meeting) for the program chairman (or their substitute) to oversee business matters, if funds are unavailable from their member organization.

Standing Rules 4. Adopted October 12, 1989 - Annual Business Meeting

The Association will appropriate to a maximum of \$200.00 to off-set AMCA meeting expenses when attending IMVCA meetings. The Executive Board will determine the need and criteria for those expenditures.

Standing Rule 5. Adopted December 20, 1989 - Executive Board

Any member requesting funding by the Association shall submit in writing their request to the Treasurer at least one month prior to the Annual Meeting. The Treasurer, upon receipt of such request, shall seek the approval of the Executive Committee prior to the Annual Meeting to determine whether request for payment will be honored.

Standing Rule 6. Adopted March 28, 1990 - Executive Board

If there is no member of the Association's Executive Committee attending the AMCA Annual Meeting with expenses being reimbursed by their District or Agency, then the Executive Committee may approve the sending of the President or a designated individual as the representative of the Association, and that incurred expenses for reimbursement shall not exceed \$500.00.

Standing Rule 7. Adopted March 28, 1990 - Executive Committee

An IMVCA Awards Committee may be established to consider certificates of awards for outstanding work performed for the Association or for years of serving on the Executive Committee.

Standing Rule 8. Adopted January 15, 1992 - Executive Committee

No refunds will be made for cancellation of pre-registration for the Annual Meeting within one week prior to the meeting.

Standing Rule 9. Adopted November 19, 1992 - Annual Business Meeting

The registration fee for the Annual Meeting will be waived for Honorary Members of the Association.

Standing Rule 10. Adopted November 19, 1992 - Annual Business Meeting

(Criteria established March 23, 1993 - Executive Committee)

The Association will participate with other associations in the Regional area in supplementing travel and accommodation expenses for the AMCA Regional Director if needed, not to exceed \$100.00. The Association must be furnished with a letter from the Regional Director or Director of their District or Agency, stating that funds have not been given by a local District or the AMCA, and that a copy of an invoice or statement from the hotel, air line, or other form of transportation be submitted to the Association as proof of need.

Standing Rule 11. Adopted November 18, 1999 - Annual Business Meeting

All nominations shall carry the consent of the nominee and assurance that they will serve if elected.

Standing Rule 12. Adopted November 14, 2002 – Annual Business Meeting

The President and Regional Director of the American Mosquito Control Association should be invited to our Annual Illinois Mosquito and Vector Control Meeting.
